THE MORIKAMI MUSEUM & JAPANESE GARDENS

Culture Shock: Situated on 16 sprawling acres, the Japanese Gardens of The Morikami reflect different periods of Nippon garden design. **Highlight:** The Hira Niwa Flat Garden (below) borrows inspiration from 17th- and 18th-century principles. The gravel, raked in a clean, circular shape, symbolizes enlightenment and happiness. **What's New:** In the Nelson Memorial Garden, the Karesansui Garden features gravel and sand raked in a pattern to mimic the flow of water. **Don't Miss:** The Morikami hosts its 33rd annual Bon Festival on August 14, an event that honors ancestors and celebrates life. morikami.org
